

A cross country history lesson of the past 100+ years has never been so fresh, hip, approachable, and evocative of everything that inspires us about our national parks. The gorgeous book walks you through the history of our national parks, often referred to as our country's "best idea" with stunning illustrations along the way by artists including one with family ties to Franklin Roosevelt -- so cool! As a lifelong national parks visitor and supporter, there were many familiar park "faces" to me along the way, but with artwork from parks in all 50 states, is certainly connects to people from all over the country - and the millions more who travel internationally to our national parks each year!

Love this book--wonderful art depicting many national parks and monuments. A paragraph of information is included with each one as well as brief profiles of the artists. Just be aware that this is a small book--only 6.5" by 8.5". That said, it will inspire you to visit more of our national natural treasures!

To be honest I was a bit disappointed. I LOVE the content of this book, but the size of the book and the images are really small for what it is. It's a book featuring images of posters, and the book is only 8x6 (yes that detail is on the listing, I know)... but it's made worse by the fact that the images are not even shown as full page. Were the book available in a larger format, with full page images I'd be buying a boatload more as gifts. What you're getting with this book is essentially just a catalog.

This is a great book. It really makes you want to see more of America and appreciate the natural beauty of our country. It definitely makes me want to get out hiking. Unlike other coffee table books I have, I actually have been showing this to guests when they come over. As well, I might order a few of these illustrations as posters as some are truly unique and inspiring. That said, I wish the book was a little larger and also a few of the images were more lackluster and were less evocative and powerful as the others.Bottom line - it's a great buy. I can't wait to see what these folks comes up with next!
