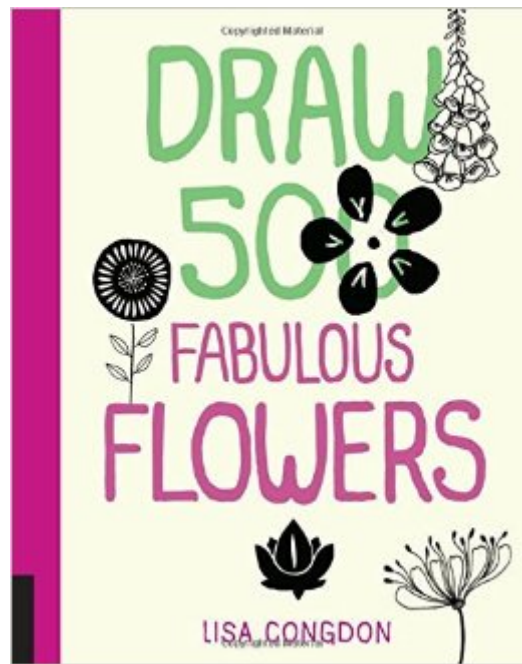

I have the original how to draw a tulip and admit I didn't realize this was the same book until I had ordered it. However the smaller size served it's purpose for me and I have used it many times since I have had it. I highly recommend it. I love Lisa Condon's work. This book is a good nudge in the right direction to start your own style.

I'm not a fan of this series of books. The main reason being that they don't really teach you

anything. It's simply a bunch of pages with doodles of whatever the subject matter is with some blank in the pages so you can try your hand in drawing them yourself. If you are using them simply for inspiration and already know how to draw then these may be for you.

Sorry, but I really don't like this book. A few of the flowers are cute but many either don't look like flowers or are complicated with no instructions whatsoever. I do know how to draw and was looking for inspiration as well as new perspective on drawing flowers. I really didn't find either in this book.

I was a bit disappointed with this book, the first I have purchased in this series by Quarry Books. I had looked inside of a couple of the "20 Ways to Draw...." books and assumed this would be the same. Those books were in an 8.5x10 inch format and had many different illustrations on each page. This book is 5.5x6.5 inches and has from one to five illustrations per page - not nearly as many examples. It will be useful, but I would have preferred to pay the extra money and get one of the "20 Ways..." books.

No tutorials just black and white drawings of very odd flowers, nothing like what I expected

Besides being useful, this is such a cute and sweet little book on drawing flowers. The book is full of 500 flowers to inspire the artist and they can be interpreted and expanded on in any way you want. I'm glad the other reviewer mentioned that "How to Draw a Tulip" is the same book because I almost ordered that one, but I went ahead and ordered the one on drawing cats, one of my favorite subjects. This is a fun and useful book to inspire the beginning artist or one who is more accomplished. I certainly recommend it.

For nearly \$12, I expected this to be SO much better. The book does nothing to show you how to draw the actual flowers. Also, the examples aren't cute and they don't look fun. I'm not inspired to try drawing any of these examples. I'd return it but it's not even worth the time or shipping cost to send it back. Her coloring books are much better and cheaper to boot.

I love this little book! It's small enough to carry in my purse. I pull it out in the doctor's office or anywhere I might have to wait for awhile. It's a great conversation starter too! All of the flowers are inspiring and I find myself doodling flowers when I'm at work. I do need to pack multiple size markers; so far I've only had a micropen with me, and I'd like to have some broader tips for coloring

in petals.
